These services are a "courtesy" to the people of GV. Please respect each of these services.

<u>The recycle center</u> is opened on Mon. & Tues from 1-3. The only time anything should be left at this area is when an attendant is on site. <u>The compost pile</u> is for leaves and grass (hay...) <u>only</u>. <u>The burn pile</u> is for other yard debris. <u>There should be no man made materials put in the compost or burn piles!</u> <u>The fire wood pile</u> is for all tree debris with a diameter over 4". Anything that does not fit in your truck doesn't belong up at the city yard.
